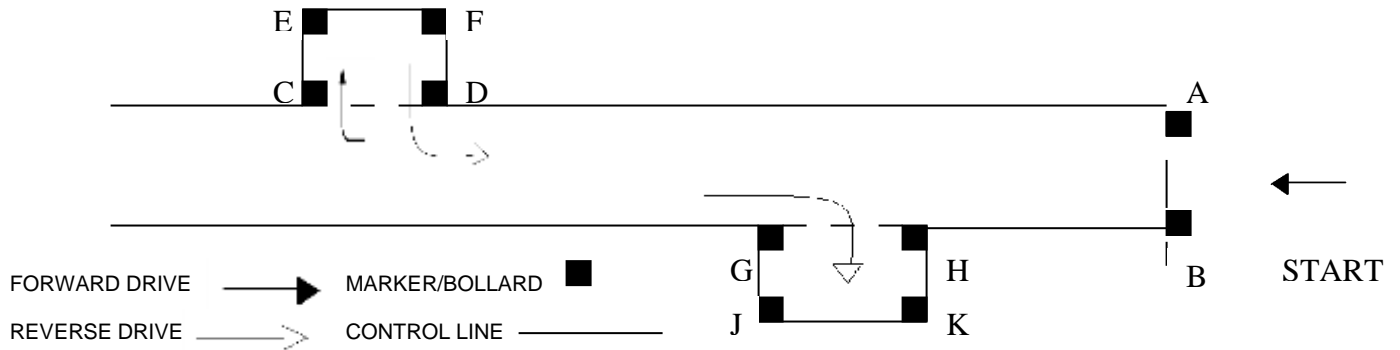


WESSEX CENTRES RALLY 2018

DRIVING AND REVERSING COMPETITION

A draw will be made for the order of taking part prior to the Wessex Centre Rally 2018 and details will be available in the Information Office. Late bookings may not be on this list.

The onus for being available to start the competition in the draw order rests with the entrant and non availability will result in disqualification.

The competition is intended to test the skill of the competitors in reversing their outfits into a “lane” on the blind side of the driver, as well as the ability to drive through a narrow gap without the sides of the caravan touching an obstruction.

Competitors will start the run with the front wheels of their outfit on the start line A-B, the car and caravan coupled, engine running and the driver at the wheel

On being given the starting signal, the outfit will be driven forward into the right hand enclosure C,D,E,F. It will then be reversed into the enclosure on the opposite side of the road until the front of the outfit crosses the enclosure line G-H and the outfit stops, with the car and caravan entirely contained within the enclosure G,H,J,K. The run will be timed from the starting signal to the moment the competitor completes the run with the outfit stationary, after the front wheels have crossed line G-H.

Only the nominated driver may drive or steer the car

The Entrant may only drive the vehicle brought by him/her to the Rally and use the caravan provided by the Organisers.

The driver may select one person to accompany him/her as a passenger.

EXCEPTION – Motor Home drivers may drive a vehicle not brought by him/herself however, the vehicle can only be used on one occasion other than the owner and spouse.

Only holders of a Full licence may take part.

The co-driver may also be a competitor in his/her own right.

A passenger, if carried, can assist in any way except steering, but must not dismount during the competition run. No practice runs on the marked course will be permitted. Penalties will be incurred for touching a marker or the marked lines of the course or deviating from the designated course as follows..

| a) Crossing a controlled line, touching a marker or bollard | Disqualification |
| b) Deviating from the designated course | Disqualification |
| c) Any door open when moving | Disqualification |
| d) On each occasion a wheel of the outfit is spun | 10 Seconds |
| e) Failure to complete the test in time:- | |
| 2 minute for Gentlemen | Disqualification |
| 4 minutes for Ladies | Disqualification |

There are no penalties (other than time) incurred by driving forward during a reversing run. The reversing stop may be in use at the start of the test.

THE JUDGES DECISION WILL BE FINAL
