

## **HANDICRAFT COMPETITION RULES 2018**

Entries are limited to one entry per person, per class

Each person must complete their own entry form

(Please do not put family members on the same form)

Each item MUST be the work of the entrant, who MUST attend the rally

Items previously entered in the handicraft section MUST NOT be re-entered

Closing date for this competition as in Rally General Rules. All entry slips to be received by Mrs T Mason no later than 31 July 2018.

ALL entries MUST be handed in at the marquee between 9am and 11am on the Sunday of the rally. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED OUTSIDE THESE TIMES. A receipt will be issued for each item to enable the owner to collect. See Rule 8 below.

Judging will take place between 11.30 am and 1.30 pm on Sunday.

Public viewing will take place between 3pm and 5pm on Sunday

Entries can be collected between 5pm and 5.30pm on Sunday, by presenting the issued receipt for the item. NO ITEM WILL BE HANDED OUT WITHOUT THE RECEIPT.

Please note: You will not be allowed to collect for anyone else without the receipt.

PLEASE NOTE!! - IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT TO ENSURE THAT ALL ITEMS ARE ENTERED INTO THE CORRECT CLASS.

### **WESSEX HANDICRAFTS – NOTES FOR GUIDANCE.**

These notes are to help you when entering the Handicrafts section of the Wessex Rally. Please follow the guidance listed below.

- If your entry does not conform to the rules as outlined on the entry form, they will not be considered for entry into the chosen class. i.e.: if it states hand sewn it means sewn, not knitted.
- If it states water colour paints, that is what is required, not an alternative medium.

Please bear in mind that restrictions are often set for the handicrafts sections. This may cause problems when finding the correct wool etc. The judges are informed if this has been the case and will judge accordingly. As external judges from the Townswomen's Guild, these ladies are trained to a very high standard and know what they are looking for. So please enter your item, even if you have used the wrong wool, it will be judged on their high standards and may earn you points for your centre.
