

Wessex Lawn Skittles 2018

Equipment

Rectangular grass area marked out with string. 3 metres wide by 5 metres deep

13 wood skittles each numbered 1 to 13. Size approx. 50mm dia x 150mm high.

2 wood pitching blocks, one weighted internally with lead to approx 1 ½ lbs.

Size approx 200mm x 70mm x 40mm.

Timber pitching marker approx. 450mm long.

Game Set Up

Set out marked grass area and set pitching marker parallel, central and 2 metres from 3 metre end

Set out skittles centrally in two rows just inside 3 metre end, the numbers at random

Game Rules

Players can use either of the wood pitching blocks, and have one throw in turn with the other players

Skittles are stood up in the position adjacent to their bases where they fall.

If the skittles fall outside of the marked area they are stood up just inside the marked area nearest to where they fall.

Players must pitch directly behind the pitch marker, not in front or to one side. Failure to do so could lead to a loss of 5 points from your score.

If a player does not score on three consecutive turns he/she is out of the game.

The game is to be played in a sportsmanlike manner at all times.

Scoring Rules

1 point scored for every skittle knocked down

If only one skittle is knocked down the points scored is that of the number on the skittle

No skittles knocked down, no points.

If more than 51 points are scored by a player, his/her score goes back to 25

Scoring skittles are those which have to be re-erected, after pitching block is retrieved .

Competition Rules

1. All team members must be 50 years of age or over
2. A team shall consist of four players one team from each centre only – 2 Male, 2 Female
3. Each game will finish when any player has 51 points. The scores of all four players in the team will be added together. The team with the highest accumulative score will be the winner of the game.

(For points details see game/scoring rules.)
4. Each match will be best of three games.

General Rules and Comments apply to all grievances, complaints and disputes. In the first instance you MUST contact your Centre Wessex Representative. Failure to comply may result in points being deducted from your Centres overall score.
